

第三届华盛顿中国文化节青少年作文大赛决赛名单发布



11月2日入围选手将接受即时命题写作挑战,当场决出优胜者

由载道网站 thez.us 承办的华盛顿中国文化节青少年作文大赛已进入第三个年头。2025年大赛以“文化的桥,连着你和我”为主题,吸引了来自全美各地,特别是大华府地区的青少年积极参与,共收到近150篇中英文投稿,其中98位同学成功入围决赛。

本届大赛的中文初选评审委员会由大华府著名侨史作家陈建戈担任主任,大华府四所中文学校希望中文学校、美中实验中学、哈维中文学校、巴尔的摩中文学校推选的资深教师李珊英、张红卫、陶颖哲、刘舒等五位老师共同组成。英文组评审则由资深英文写作专家 John Noran 担任评委主任。

线下决赛首次举行

11月2日(星期日),大赛将首次在大华府地区举行线下现场决赛。入围选手将分中、英文两组接受即时命题写作挑战,评审专家现场阅卷、当场打分,结合初赛成绩,最终评选出优胜者。

本次现场评审团由来自新闻媒体、文学学术界与文化机构的资深专家组成。全美中文学校协会担任本届大赛的指导单位。

参赛选手不仅来自大华府地区,还有来自亚利桑那州、加利福尼亚州等地的学生,以及来自越南的华裔青年。由于今年是首次举行线下比赛,组委会暂未同步开展线上赛事,但计划未来推出线上线下结合的全国性写作活动,以满足更多热爱中华文化与写作的青少年的参与需求。

Finalists Announced for the 3rd Washington Chinese Culture Festival Junior Essay Competition

Finalists to Compete in On-Site Writing Challenge on November 2, Where Winners Will Be Determined on the Spot

Hosted by the bilingual youth platform thez.us, the Washington Chinese Culture Festival Junior Essay Competition has entered its third year. The 2025 competition, themed “Bridging Cultures Connecting You and Me,” has attracted enthusiastic participation from students across the United States, particularly from the Greater Washington D.C. area. Nearly 150 Chinese and English essays were submitted, and 98 students have advanced to the final round.

The Chinese preliminary judging panel is chaired by Mr. Jiange Chen, a renowned Chinese American historian and writer. Senior teachers Shanying Li, Hongwei Zhang, Yingzhe Tao, and Shu Liu from four leading Chinese schools—Hope Chinese School, American Chinese School, Howard Chinese School, and Baltimore Chinese School—joined as co-judges. The English panel is led by veteran writing expert Mr. John Noran.

On-Site Finals to Be Held for the First Time

On Sunday, November 2, the competition will host its first-ever in-person final in the Greater Washington area. Finalists will be divided into Chinese and English groups and challenged with an on-site prompt writing task. Judges will review and score the essays immediately, combining preliminary and final scores to determine the winners.

The judging panel consists of respected professionals from the media, literary, academic, and cultural fields. The competition is guided by the Association of Chinese Schools in the United States (ACCS).

In addition to local participants, contestants come from Arizona, and other states, as well as Vietnamese-Chinese youth from abroad. Since this year marks the competition's first in-person event, there will be no online round. However, the organizing committee plans to launch a hybrid online-offline format in future years to engage young writers nationwide who share a passion for Chinese culture and writing.
